## COMPETITORS

Competitors (male/female) participating in competitions must be at the age of 16 to 39 years old on the starting day of the competitions and must be black belt certificate holders.

## COACHES

Only one coach for sparring is allowed to represent team on the ring. Coach must wear tracksuit and gymnastic shoes.

## UMPIRES

Each team must provide at least 1 umpire, not less than 3rd Degree holder, having umpire qualification or international tournament umpire experience, otherwise the team will get a penalty of 100 EUR.

**PARTICIPATION FEE.** Overall fee - **400 EUR per team.**

## 6. ACCOMMODATION.

Rooms of the hotel are comfortable and cozy. All the rooms are equipped with the electronic key locks. There is video control in the security system of the hotel.

## 7. ACCREDITATION AND REGISTRATION

Accreditation and registration of competitors, referees, umpires, officials, coaches and guests of the Tournament in hotel "Moscow" from 10.00 to 19.00. on 6-7<sup>th</sup> December, 2007.

Application of an approved type from authorized official of a team, the identity document of the competitor, the permission of the doctor, the medical insurance and Dan-certificate ITF are necessary to be admitted to the registration.

While the accreditation the competitors will receive numbers, to be fixed on the back of doboks

## 9. VISA.

In case you need visa T.O.C. can provide 2 kinds of invitation, according to Consulate requirements:

1. Personal invitation (official form of Saint-Petersburg Taekwon-Do Federation).
2. Official personal hotel invitation-voucher (only for those who books accommodation in "Moscow" Hotel). Cost of invitation-voucher is 750 rub.

**By air:** There are two airports in the city:

Pulkovo-2 for international flights

Pulkovo-1 for domestic flights

**By train:** There are 5 railway stations in the city.

**By bus:** "Eurolines" company provides regular bus trips from/to Saint-Petersburg and European cities.





## 11. INFORMATION ON THE CITY

### PROFILE OF ST. PETERSBURG

St. Petersburg is the second largest city in Russia with a population of over five million people. It is a major intellectual, cultural, financial, commercial and industrial centre of the Russian Federation. "The City of Peter" serves as a major transportation centre as well as an educational, publishing, and research centre with more than 400 scientific research institutes. Its architecture, world masterpieces, "White nights" and drawbridges attract millions of tourists every year.

### HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The Russian Tsar Peter the Great, who led Russians to recapture from Sweden, the area that in now northwest Russia, founded the city of St. Petersburg in 1703 and ordered that his imperial capital be moved from Moscow to St. Petersburg, where it remained until the Bolsheviks returned the seat of Russian power back to the Moscow Kremlin in 1918. The Bolsheviks also changed the city's name to Leningrad shortly after Lenin's death in 1924. St. Petersburg residents voted to restore the city's original name on September 6, 1991. There was also a period from 1914 to 1917 when it was named Petrograd.

### LOCAL TIME

Time in St. Petersburg is 3 hours ahead of GMT.

### WEATHER

The average temperature for December is -7 C (19.4 F), usually with snow.

### RELIGION

The Russian Orthodox Church is dominant among the religions present in the city.

### MONEY

The Rouble is the national currency.

### EXCHANGE RATE

The current exchange rate is approximately 25 Roubles to the Dollar and 34 Roubles to the Euro. Foreign currency can be changed to Russian money at the banks, hotels or Exchange Bureaus. Credit cards are widely accepted.

### LANGUAGE

The Russian language spoken by the whole population of Russia has the official status within the country. Besides, there are over 100 minorities speaking their own languages. An increasing number of people speak English.

### ELECTRICITY

Electricity in Russia is 220 Volts, AC, 50 Hz.

Most electrical sockets are of standard European size to fit two-pin plugs.

To be sure bring an adapter with you or ask at the reception.
